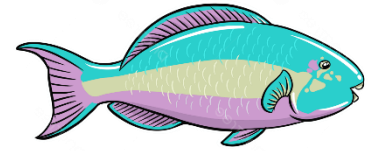

Term 1 Curriculum Plan

ENGLISH

Examining Persuasion in Advertisements and Product Packaging

The focus for this unit is examining persuasion in advertisements and product packaging. Students will engage with various product packaging, in particular cereal boxes. They will make connections to their own experiences, describing likes and dislikes about familiar product packaging.

For their assessment, students will respond to a cereal box stimulus, as well as plan and design a breakfast cereal package. They will then present their cereal package and listen and respond to others'.

MATHS

Counting Process, Additive, and Multiplicative Strategies

Students will partition and combine collections, equally share collections, and add and take away from collections. Year One will also skip count in twos, fives, and tens, and partition one- and two-digit numbers in different ways, including demonstrating that two-digit numbers can be partitioned into tens, and ones.

For their assessment, students will represent numbers in different ways and design and play a counting game.

SCIENCE

Our Material World

The focus of this unit is describing the properties of familiar objects. Students will design and make a wind ornament from common materials.

For their assessment, students will share and reflect on observations, and ask and respond to questions about their wind ornament.

TECHNOLOGY

Robots and Computers!

The focus for this unit is to build a deep understanding of the different types of computers, as well as their components. Students will also create simple algorithms that command a robot to move from one place to another across a defined path.

For their assessment, students complete a diagram and visually depict a simple algorithm.

HPE

Athletics

The focus of the health unit is to identify what make them special and unique. Students will learn that it is okay to have a different favourite colour or food from a friend. They will also identify something they are proud of (an achievement or a creation). In PE the focus of the unit is to learn skills such as running, jumping and throwing which will help them for the upcoming Athletics Carnival.

For their health assessment students will complete it in two parts. The first part is a written/drawn section answering questions about what makes them unique. The second part is a presentation in front of the class about an item or achievement they are proud of. In PE students will not be assessed however, they will showcase their skills at the Athletics Carnivals.
